These forms will then be processed by the Diocesan Safeguarding Office. This is one of the most important information evenings for our Parish. 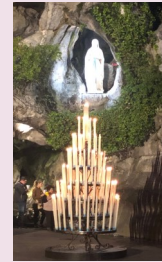
PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES 2020

Information received from the Archbishop.

Following on the detailed advice issued by the HSE at the weekend, essential in the coming days and weeks is that everyone follows both the prescribed hand hygiene and respiratory hygiene.

- Regarding Sunday celebrations, the advice given is that the following should be suspended:
- The Sign of Peace
- The practice of shaking hands on greeting and departure
- The use of holy water fonts
- The practice of receiving Holy Communion on the tongue
- The use of communal vessels

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HANDS.

It is requested that we must not receive communion on the tongue. During these days of uncertainty with the Corona Virus we should only receive Communion in the hand. If you do not wish to do this then you will not be given Communion on the tongue. Please respect this directive until further notice. We ask you also not to compromise the health and safety of those who are distributing Communion and also those who will follow you as they too receive. This directive is given to all churches and not just to our parish. It is important that we work together and do all we can to eradicate this virus.
